Featuring a selection of photographs celebrating the centennial of the Alaska-Yukon Pacific Exposition, this 2,500 square-foot gallery provides a tasteful backdrop for any special event. McEachern Auditorium

McEachern Auditorium is a professionally equipped 373-seat theatre-style performance and presentation space suitable for a wide variety of uses. The adjacent lobby can accommodate pre- and post-event functions, has a separate outside entrance, and is ADA accessible.
