Facilities available: Daily from 7am – midnight.

Catering: Choose from among recommended caterers, or bring your own for an additional fee.

Fees: Security damage deposit of \$250.00 reserves event space.

Full event fees are due three weeks prior to the event (in addition to security deposit).

ADA: Fully accessible – parking, ramps, restrooms.

Parking: 160 free parking spots on site.

Insurance: Client must provide adequate liability insurance policy and endorsement.

Miscellaneous: Inquire about educational programs, and additional gallery access.

Event Services

Seating: 250 folding chairs, 20-6' tables; 20-60" rounds, 6-30" bistro tables.

Bar facilities: Client or caterer provides liquor, bartender, banquet permit or liquor license.

Dance floor: Available through party rental agencies (NOTE: Brinkley and Carkeek Galleries have solid, non-carpeted floors ideal for dancing).

Decorations: Weighted balloons, centerpieces and votive candles permitted (dependent upon gallery). No glitter or confetti permitted. Artifacts and exhibits must not be disturbed.

Cleanup: Facility restored to original condition; all event-related materials and garbage removed from building and grounds by client unless otherwise specified.

Audio Visual: LCD projector, Slide projectors, screen, microphones (wired or wireless), overhead, CD player, cassette player, flip chart, portable PA system, easels, TV/VCR, laptop, Internet.

Auditorium equipment

Stage: Oak parquet, approximately 38' wide x 22' deep x 32" high

Lighting: Versatile repertory plot, 48 instruments, 24 dimmers

Sound: Sound system with stereo front speakers and mono back fill, 16-channel mixing board, 2 stage monitors.

Other amenities: 373 padded seats (raked and numbered); 13' x 20' screen; long lens slide projectors with remote; upright piano; 2 dressing rooms; loading dock; adjacent lobby with public entrance; fully air-conditioned and carpeted.
